Each year, on or around March 14th we have been doing random acts of kindness or special/good deeds as our way to celebrate Nolan. This year we are continuing our tradition but doing something a little more specific.

Everyone who knew Nolan knows how much he loved soccer. This year Sophie and I have partnered with Blue River Soccer Association (BRSA) to create a fund to help families who may be experiencing financial hardship access money to pay for a portion of their child(s) registration fees so they can play soccer.

BRSA Soccer dues for the 2023 season are \$70 per child.

It is the intention of BRSA that youth players interested and committed to playing soccer for the Club not be denied due to extenuating financial circumstances and this is what led to the idea and creation of this fund.

We understand that families have unique situations and financial obligations which may require assistance. The monies in this fund will be available to these families by application request and will go towards covering the registration fees for players who need it.

BRSA Application for NOLAN fund scholarship

On March 14, 2023, Kristin and Sophie Parker partnered with BRSA to establish the NOLAN fund. The NOLAN fund was created to help families who may be experiencing financial hardship access money to pay for a portion of their child(s) registration fees so they can play soccer. This fund was established in honor of Nolan Parker who was a very talented soccer player and beloved young man. Nolan passed away March 14, 2020 in a tragic car accident. He was a senior at Shelbyville High School. Nolan loved soccer. Nolan started playing soccer as a young boy at BRSA and advanced to playing travel soccer and continued all thru school. After graduation he was to continue his soccer career at Franklin College.

It is the intention of BRSA that youth players interested and committed to playing soccer for the Club not be denied due to extenuating financial circumstances and this is what lead to the idea and creation of this fund. Families have unique situations and financial obligations which may require assistance.

Blue River Soccer Association is pleased to offer scholarships thru the NOLAN fund. Eligibility is determined each season for recreation program fees. One application needs to be completed per family with all children listed and their division. Applications need to be submitted before registration closes for the applicable season. The amount of assistance given to each player is determined on an individual basis, and families will be notified within one – two weeks of receiving application. Registration will need to then be completed online. Scholarship recipients will receive a code to use during the registration check-out process to apply the awarded funds to the registration fees.

Confidentiality:

All information is for the sole purpose of assisting the BRSA Financial Committee to make scholarship decisions. Family information is strictly confidential and will not be shared with anyone.
